

We can receive indulgences. What are indulgences? Indulgences are the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sin whose guilt has already been forgiven. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. The Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the Saints. – The conditions are: a prayerful visiting of a cemetery, attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion and saying Creed and Our Father in the pope's intention.

Lord, make me capable of welcoming what is new in the Gospel of the Beatitudes, so that I may change my life. The Beatitudes are guides to the paths and on the path of life of faith. In the Beatitudes Jesus proclaims the kingdom of God, and he begins with a repeated promise of happiness. Happiness is announced to people who are still in a miserable situation and their happiness is based on the future promise of God. People who have still not been set free from their state of need, have already a God who is committed to making them happy. To be happy, Jesus says, it is not necessary for us to escape from our need. It is enough to know that God has already declared that he is on our side. The best assurance that one day our fortunes will change stems from the fact that God has already chosen those who search for him. Only a God like this can make us happy, even if we still lack many things... Jesus devoted himself to preaching the good news of the love of God to all who had need of him... Jesus tells us that those who do not accept poverty or persecution, suffering and hunger, peace and purity of heart as their task, will not have God in the life to come. For this reason, and this reason alone, they will never be truly happy in this life.
