Mgr. Emilius Goulet, p.s.s., Archbishop: Born in the Quebec village of Saint Isidore-de-Dorchester, ordained a priest for the Diocese of St. Boniface, Manitoba, on June 24, 1958. He served for five years as General Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. He was Rector at the Canadian Pontifical College in Rome and ecclesiastical adviser to

Canadian Embassy to the Vatican when elected on June 23, 2001 the 7th bishop and 6th archbishop of St. Boniface.
