



Nedelja, 17. januar: – *Kaj iščeta*, je Jezusovo vprašanje. Kaj iščeš nas vprašuje Jezus. Smo se morda kdaj iskreno vpračali, kaj iščemo? Iščemo morda nekaj, kar je nepomembno, kar je daleč, kar je nemogoče? Iskati pomeni hrepeneti. Gotovo hreponimo po sreči, miru in zadovoljstvu. Takšno hrepenenje ni ne previsdoko in ne po nečem nemogočem.

Jezus je rekel : *Pridita in bosta videla*. Jezus tudi nas osebno in vedno znova nagovarja in vabi: *Pridi in poglej*. Priti moramo k Jezusu in z njim gledati, gledati tja in tako, kot nas uči, ker as želi pripeljati do prave sreče, veselja in miru. Prosimo Jezus, naj nam pomaga, da bomo slišali njegovo besedo,

njegovo vabilo in odgovorili in tako prišli k njemu, da bo vodil in utrjeval naše hrepenenje, da bomo hodili po poti, ki nam jo on kaže – pot vere in zaupanja.

Many times, in the Gospels it is said that Jesus fixes His look on His disciples, or on a particular person. He fixes His look to love, to call, to enlighten. His look never leaves us. I know that I can find peace by exchanging this look. How can I pretend not to see? Why continue to turn my look from here to there, fleeing from the Lord's love which has been given to me and has chosen me?... "They followed Jesus." This expression referred to the disciples. It does not only mean that they began to walk in the same direction with Christ, but much more: that they consecrated themselves to Him, that they committed their life with Him and for Him. He is the one who takes the initiative. He tells me: "You, follow Me", like with the rich young man and with Peter. How do I respond? Do I have the courage, the love, the ardor, to tell Him: "Master, I will follow You wherever You go!", confirming these words with the facts? Or do I also say, like the one in the Gospel: "I will follow You, but first allow me to...." The disciples remain with Jesus, they begin to live with Him, and to have the house in common with Him. Perhaps, they began to feel and experience that the Lord himself is their new house.

BOŽJA BESEDA: – Prihodnja nedelja se letos drugič po vsem katoliškem svetu obhaja kot nedelja Božje besede. Božja beseda nam razodeva Božjo usmiljeno ljubezen, nas uči, kako naj živimo, da se bo to usmiljenje pretakalo v naša srca in bomo živeli z Jezusom, ki večna Božja Beseda.

Papež Frančišek: *Sredi krize, sredi teme v duši mnogih ljudi kot Janez Krstnik, Jezus poveljuje Očeta, Jezus hvali Očeta. A zakaj? Predvsem ga hvali za to, kar je: »Oče, Gospod neba in zemlje.« Jezus se v svojem duhu raduje, saj ve in čuti, da je njegov Oče Bog vesoljstva, in obratno, Gospod vsega, kar obstaja, je Oče, »moj Oče«. Iz te izkušnje, da se čuti »sin Najvišjega« izvira hvaljenje. Jezus se čuti sin Najvišjega. V težkih in temnih trenutkih, imejmo pogum reči: »Blagoslovljen, Gospod« Hvaliti Gospoda. To nam bo zelo dobro delo.*
